3 Night Murray River Discovery Cruise - Optional Ex Melbourne

Cruises depart Port of Echuca, Riverboat Dock, Echuca at 2.30 pm and return at 9.30 am. See Calendar for Departure Days.

DAY 1

Departing Echuca and steaming downriver, enjoy afternoon tea with freshly made scones served with jam & cream and your choice of tea or coffee. Relax and enjoy the sights and sounds of the river or take the opportunity to chat with the Engineer or with the Skipper in the wheelhouse about the rich history of the river and PS Emmylou. As the sun starts to set over the river it's time for an evening cocktail before sitting down to dinner. Listen to the river birds evening chorus, watch for kangaroos, wombats, egrets and many other species of birds as the stars begin to appear. Tonight, we moor at the famous Perricoota Station. Rich in history, the property was first settled by James Maiden in 1843, and famous for starring in the TV mini series "All the River Run" where PS Emmylou was renamed PS Providence.

DAY 2

This morning we depart on a half day excursion travelling to the small town of Barmah for a guided Eco Cruise, where you can get up close to Australian nature and wildlife gliding through the World-Heritage listed Barmah Wetlands aboard the MV Kingfisher. Enjoy a picnic lunch riverside before we continue to the region's largest winery, St Anne's where you will enjoy a

winery tour provided by the owners and taste their fabulous table and fortified wines. Arriving back at Perricoota Station join a guided walking tour of the buildings and vast gardens scattered with old date palms before PS Emmylou continues upriver towards Deep Creek Marina. Tonight, after dinner, it's movie night, with a special presentation of "Riverboats Remembered" a fabulous historical presentation featuring archival footage of the paddle steamers and communities of the Murray River from the early 1900's through to the mid 1970's.

DAY 3

This morning we depart on a full day of cruising towards our Layfield Lane Mooring. Enjoy the river views and wildlife as Emmylou steams her way upstream. Today you can learn how the 1906 steam engine works with an informative chat from our Engineer. Tonight, enjoy sampling the delicious range of Pacdon Park UK small goods for entrée before joining your fellow passengers at the riverside grand dining table for our signature Australian BBQ, star lit by the Southern Cross and candles followed by some yarns sitting around the campfire.

DAY 4

This morning before breakfast early risers can enjoy a riverside stroll before PS Emmylou then departs for the Port of Echuca where we reluctantly say farewell.
