4 Night Murray River Explorer Cruise - Optional Ex Melbourne

Cruises depart Port of Echuca, Riverboat Dock, Echuca at 2.30 pm and return at 9.30 am. See Calendar for Departure Days.

DAY 1

Departing Echuca and steaming downriver, enjoy afternoon tea with freshly made scones as you immerse yourself in the sights and sounds of the river. Take the opportunity to chat with the Engineer or the Skipper. As the sun starts to set it's time for 'Happy Hour' in the Saloon before a welcome dinner. Tonight we moor at the famous Perricoota Station. Rich in history, the property was first settled by James Maiden in 1843, and is famous for starring in the TV mini series "All the River Run" where PS Emmylou was renamed PS Providence.

DAY 2

Wake to your first morning on the river as you enjoy breakfast. Afterward it's off to Restdown Winery, producers of fine organic wines and Hereford beef. Join the property's owners for a guided tour along a 1.4km wetlands walking trail highlighting items of great Aboriginal significance. This is followed by a gourmet lunch of local produce with complimentary wine tastings. Returning to the Emmylou we continue downstream for Torrumbarry Weir. Here you can take a walk across the weir and visit the Interpretive Centre learning about the Murray Darling Basin, the weir and lock system which dates back to 1923.

DAY 3

This morning we steam upstream towards Perricoota Station where we depart to on a half

day excursion travelling 30 minutes to the small town of Barmah. Enjoy a traditional Australian picnic lunch riverside before departing on your guided Eco Cruise, gliding through the World-Heritage listed Barmah Wetlands aboard the MV Kingfisher. Upon your return join the Skipper for a walk past the gardens and buildings of Perricoota Station. We then continue cruising towards Deep Creek. Enjoy dinner as Emmylou steams into the night with her powerful lamps lighting up the banks of the river. After dinner enjoy a special presentation of "Riverboats Remembered", a fabulous historical presentation featuring the paddle steamers of the Murray River from the early 1900's through to the mid 1970's.

DAY 4

This morning we depart on a full day of cruising towards our Layfield Lane Mooring. Enjoy the river views and wildlife as Emmylou steams her way upstream. Today you can learn how the 1906 steam engine works with an informative chat from our Engineer. Tonight, enjoy sampling the delicious range of Pacdon Park UK small goods for entrée before joining your fellow passengers at the riverside grand dining table for our signature Australian BBQ, star lit by the Southern Cross and candles followed by some yarns sitting around the campfire.

DAY 5

This morning before breakfast early risers can enjoy a riverside stroll before PS Emmylou then departs for the Port of Echuca where we reluctantly say farewell.
