DAY 1

Departing Echuca and steaming downriver, enjoy a welcome afternoon tea with freshly baked scones served with jam & cream and your choice of tea or coffee. As the sun starts to set it's time for an evening cocktail before sitting down to dinner. Tonight, we moor at the famous Perricoota Station. Rich in history, the property was first settled by James Maiden in 1843, and is famous for starring in the TV mini-series "All the River Run" where PS Emmylou was renamed PS Providence.

DAY 2

This morning we depart on a half day excursion to the small town of Barmah. Here you board the MV Kingfisher for a guided Eco Cruise, where you can get up close to Australian nature and wildlife. Enjoy the timeless, natural beauty gliding through the World-Heritage listed Barmah Wetlands. This is followed by a riverside picnic lunch and a visit to St Anne's winery for a cellar door tour with the owners.

6 Night All the Rivers Run Cruise

Arriving back at Perricoota Station join a guided walking tour of the buildings and vast gardens. This afternoon we cruise downstream towards Torrumbarry Weir.

DAY 3

This morning we depart on our day tour. You will visit Lake Bogo Flying Boat Museum and explore the famous Swan Hill Pioneer Settlement where lunch will be served. Upon your return to the Emmylou you can take a guided walk across the weir, visiting the Interpretive Centre and learning about the Murray Darling Basin and the weir and lock system which dates to 1923 before enjoying dinner overlooking the Weir. It is then time for movie night. With a special presentation of "Riverboats Remembered", a fabulous historical presentation featuring archival footage of the paddle steamers and communities of the Murray River from the early 1900's through to the mid 1970's.

DAY 4

This morning PS Emmylou departs cruising upstream towards Perricoota Station. We then depart for our onshore half day tour visiting Restdown Winery, producers of fine organic wines and Hereford beef. Here you can join the properties owners for a guided 1.4km wetlands walk along a trail highlighting items of great Aboriginal significance. This is followed by a gourmet lunch of local produce with complementary wine tastings. Upon arrival back at Perricoota Station we continue our journey upstream enjoying dinner

as we cruise towards our overnight mooring at Deep Creek Marina.

DAY 5

This morning PS Emmylou departs on a full day of cruising towards Layfield Lane, arriving late afternoon. Today you can learn how the 1906 steam engine works with an informative chat from our Engineer. Tonight, enjoy sampling the delicious range of Pacdon Park UK small goods for entrée before joining your fellow passengers at the riverside grand dining table for our signature Australian BBQ, star lit by the Southern Cross and candles. After dinner enjoy some yarns sitting around the campfire before retiring for the evening.

DAY 6

Enjoy breakfast on the deck then relax as we cruise towards the Port of Echuca. This afternoon you depart on a fully narrated tour of Echuca and its historic port, once the centre of Australia's thriving inland trade. You will visit historic sites and learn about the rich history of this beautiful riverside town. This afternoon and evening we cruise upstream from Echuca exploring the upper river enjoying dinner as the sun sets over the river before tying up for the evening at Morrisons Winery. Tonight, enjoy the final special presentation of All the Rivers Run.

DAY 7

This morning before breakfast early risers can enjoy a morning bush walk before PS Emmylou departs for the Port of Echuca where we reluctantly say farewell.
